Emmaus Needs You!

Over the years of being involved with our beautiful, loving Darke County Area Emmaus Community, I have been blessed to meet multitudes of God-loving Christ-followers, many of whom have become dear, close friends. I have seen hundreds take the gifts and blessings they received, sharing them with others to help them become faithful servants of God! Yet, there is a sadness in my heart as I watch the number of our active servants in the Emmaus Community dwindle. Don't get me wrong, those who attend the Gatherings are incredible people! They bring me joy, and I am blessed to be around them. I am encouraged by them.

Over the last several years, however, I have also heard complaints concerning how the teams that serve on a weekend are chosen. Some ask why they never get called; some, having served on several consecutive walks, feel upset that they weren't chosen for the team — and don't know why.

I will do my best to explain some of the reasons:

To be selected, there should be consistent involvement in Emmaus' Community events. For example: monthly Gatherings, serving in the kitchen on weekends, showing up to help welcome the new pilgrims get settled on Thursdays' send-off, being a part of the Candlelight service, helping at tear-down on Sunday afternoon before the closing ceremony, cleaning bathrooms on the weekend, helping in the Agape Room, etc. From this list, you can choose what works best for your schedule. But, if we don't see you, many of us may not remember you (old age can play havoc on memory!). When it is time to select the teams through vigilant prayer, God leads us by reminding us of those we see serving. Through this, we believe they are available and willing to serve. Consequently, we want to see you. We want to have a good, strong relationship with you and provide an opportunity for His sake and purposes. Bottom line: SHOW UP! That's how we get to know you and your gifts.

Another situation we face is those who feel hurt, angry and frustrated because they weren't selected after having served consecutively 4 or 5 teams. There is an assumption that they should be on the team.

The Upper Room designed the Emmaus Weekend so that a person is not to serve on more than two teams consecutively for the purpose of allowing more of the community to get involved. This enables us to continue our personal growth and maturity in our spiritual walk. Stop thinking so highly of yourself and let God do His work in growing His Kingdom (see Phil. 2:3-4). God doesn't NEED you. He freely chooses you. It is for His plan, not yours.

We are all the Beloved of God. He will bless the humble and resist the proud (James 4:6). When He sees you are serving Him, caring enough about the Walk to Emmaus Weekend Ministry by being a part of all that is offered through our community, He will call you. Remember, though, when He calls – give Him the glory and honor. Rejoice that He has promoted you to servant! Prepare yourself to humbly serve Him. Show up! We have opportunities to serve at the Darke County Fair and at the upcoming Illumination Festival. God wants you to join Him there!

We meet each month to pray for our Emmaus Community and to continue the wonderful Emmaus experience for future pilgrims. Women's Walk #55 is fast approaching. The Board asked and the Community responded! As you are aware, we are making a transition to a new location for our Walk Weekends.

Sponsor a cot!

One advantage of holding our walks at the camp was having beds. With moving to a church facility, we need to provide beds for our pilgrims and live-in team. The Board of Directors voted to purchase cots instead of the air mattresses as previously used. Researching the market, we found good, sturdy cots that costs \$50 each and asked the Emmaus Community to join us in sponsoring a cot for \$50. Our goal was to raise \$3,000 to purchase 60 cots. I am so excited to report that we have raised \$3,025.00 and 60 cots have been purchased!! Praise God!! We serve a Mighty God and this Mighty God is moving in our local Emmaus Community. Come, join us each month at our monthly Gatherings to stay connected to the Community and sign-up to serve at Women's Walk #55 to shower the pilgrims with God's never-ending love.

AGAPE Reminders—

Women's Walk #55 will be here before you know it. Oct. 31– Nov. 3, 2024.

Get your creative juices flowing, there are lots of ideas for table or bedtime agape.

Here are a few guidelines to follow for writing and making agape:

- **#1** Please put your name on your agape and on agape containers/bags, leftovers will be available to pick up at the closing of the weekend and for 2 gatherings afterward. Whatever hasn't been claimed after that will be donated to the Chrysalis community.
- **#2** NO PERSONAL AGAPE for pilgrims until Sunday for their packets. This can be only letters, notes and cards, or whatever will fit into an envelope. No large agape will be accepted such as mugs, t-shirts, framed pictures or books, please give these items to them after their walk. Agape can be no larger than what will fit into a 9"x12"manila envelope.
- **#3** Team and pilgrim agape must have first and last name on the front of the envelope. And for team agape it also must have the day you want them to receive it or it will be put in the Sunday packet. There have been times when we have had more than one person with the same first name and your agape could go to the wrong person.

Let's show these pilgrims what agape love is all about!

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PERSONAL AGAPE ENVELOPES

Write the Pilgrim's first and last name on the envelope, then, on the bottom left-hand corner, write, "Pilgrim." Remember that they receive their agape on Sunday only. For team members, write their first and last name on the envelope, then, on the bottom left-hand corner, write, "Team member" and the specific day you want them to receive the agape.
